### **LSF Central Coast Adult Services: Staff Member Training**

SF Central Coast Adult Service took the summer to provide training to all of our staff members. The training that was provided was Nonviolent Crisis Intervention. Each staff member received a certification upon completion of the training. Even though it is our staff members that completed the training, it really benefits our individuals and the way our staff members interact with them. Our staff now have the knowledge and skills to recognize, prevent, and manage any crisis behaviors using person-centered and trauma-informed responses, which consists of:

- Recognizing that the individual knows themselves best
- Considering the individuals life experiences
- Understanding that every individual is unique
- Valuing the individual's rights and dignity

This training established a common philosophy and framework of care, welfare, safety, and security benefiting our program site, staff, and the individuals we serve. We now have a better understanding of the individual's behavior, its risk level, and are able to provide an integrated experience between the staff members and individuals. In addition, we know how to use disengagement skills if needed due to this training.
