LSF Children and Family Services in Southern California: Participant Spotlight



iam was an energetic and happy little boy who was always excited for session time. He was referred to Life Steps Foundation for early intervention services at 26 months of age due to his parents' concerns about his speech and language development, and his social-emotional development. Liam initially showed delays in his overall development. He had difficulties expressing his needs and communicating with others because he only had a few words. He had a short attention span, and he was easily irritated. When he was angry or when his needs were not met, he screamed and cried for a long time. Liam also engaged in aggressive behaviors, such as pulling hair, when he was excited or frustrated. Parents felt helpless and frustrated with Liam's

emotions and behaviors. After receiving early intervention services, our early interventionist (EI) provided resources to the parents to help them understand Liam's development. The El discussed with the parents strategies to decrease Liam's screaming and aggressive behaviors. Our El also worked on improving Liam's speech and language skills with a variety of activities, as well as monitoring Liam's overall development. At the time Liam exited the program, his behaviors and speech and language skills had greatly improved. He was able to recite familiar songs and share past experiences with his parents. He had developed appropriate behaviors and social skills to interact with peers. His parents were happy with Liam's improvement, and they felt empowered as they learned many strategies to help Liam regulate his emotions. It is a jov to work with this family. I am sure the family will continue to support Liam's development with their love and care.
